

Year 11 Music – Revision Guidance

Although discussed in class in more detail, here is a bullet point reminder of the topics for your revision:

- Dimensions of Music: melody, articulation, dynamics, tempo, harmony, sonority, rhythm/metre, tonality, structure, texture. Are you clear what each word refers to? You have definitions in your book and on Teams.
- Vocabulary related to each Dimension of Music – learn the associated words that match each dimension e.g. dynamics questions will need answers like crescendo, forte etc. You have a full list of the terms in your glossary (in your folder) and there are copies on Teams.
- Complete revision on each of the set works: 'Badinerie' and 'Africa' (all copies of notes on Teams and in your folders). Make sure you listen to the set works.
- Revise Areas of Study 1, 3 & 4 that have been completed so far.
- Complete some dictation practice on <https://www.teoria.com/en/exercises/> (melody and rhythm dictation)

Remember it is a listening exam so you must think about how you recognise the keywords by sound. Try testing yourself by analysing unfamiliar pieces of music.
